AMY'S VIEW


Amy's View written by British playwright, David Hare launches the 50^{th} anniversary year of The Stirling Players. The play is set in England and the action takes place over a sixteen year period, from 1979 - 1995.

Well-known West End actress, Esme Allen, receives a visit from her daughter Amy, together with her new boyfriend, Dominic Tyghe. This sets in motion a series of events which only fully come into shape 16 years later and takes the audience on a tense and emotional journey between a strong mother and her loving daughter.

The cast includes: Jo St Clair, Rose Harvey, Simon Barnett, Jill Morrell, Steve Marvanek & Jackson Barnard. Rehearsals began in January.



David Hare's characters are renowned for being "real people with real flaws, struggling with their own lives and succeeding as best they can." This is what Tim Williams, says is the reason he chose to direct the play for The Stirling Players. "What is quite different about this play from others that I have directed is that we follow the characters over 16 years of their lives so we see each character evolve as the years progress and that is proving exciting to work through"

MEET OUR NEW PRESIDENT JOHN GRAHAM

John was elected as The Stirling Players President for 2022 at the AGM held on 6 February. He is not new to the role. In fact his first foray as president of the group was in 1973! And he remained on the committee in some role until 1978. And then again as Vice President in the late 1990s/early 2000s.

Yes, you will realise, with this being our 50th anniversary year, that John was one of the group's founding members, and that his contribution over the years has been considerable. His name is up there with other wellknown stalwarts of the group: Tom Dyster, Miss Jo Lyons and Judy Riederer who banded together to form a community theatre group in 1972, and rescue the iconic building (now known as The Stirling Community Theatre) from demolition. It was earmarked for a supermarket!!! What a coup!

And of course, it was not surprising when the group was under threat of disbandment in 2020, that John was happy to serve on committee again. And he went from there to take on the role of Vice President in July-2021, and Acting President in October 2021. During this time he has chaired or been a member of at least three Stirling Players sub-committees as well. And significantly, he led the group that dealt with Constitution Amendment and development of an all-important Governance Policy to 'shore' up the flagging strategic future of the group.

But John has taken on various other roles as part of the group including make-up (even a workshop on stage make-up), FOH, set construction and design, audition panel member, and actor and director. He has directed or acted in 21 productions. *The Man who Came to Dinner* has to be one of the most memorable. He spent the whole play as the 'not so welcome guest' in a wheel-chair!

Among his directing accolades are his two awardwinning productions;- 'It's my Party and I'll Die if I Want to' for Best Comedy in the 2008 Curtain Call Awards and 'Family Lore' in the 1995 Hills Drama Festival. And just as an aside, John also chaired and was a committee member of the Hills Drama Festival of One Act Plays. This was a unique festival which for many years involved local community hills theatre groups in friendly competitive networking.

John was made a Life Member at our 2022 AGM!

As his sponsor so aptly said in her supportive speech, "We can literally say The Stirling Players wouldn't be where they are without you, John. It is high time you received recognition for your foresight and commitment over the last 50 years". Thank you.
